BREAKDANCING

OVERVIEW

Break dancing, also called breaking and B-boying, is an energetic form of dance, fashioned and popularised by African Americans and U.S. Latinos, that includes stylised footwork and athletic moves such as back spins or head spins. Break dancing originated in New York City during the late 1960s and early '70s, incorporating moves from a variety of sources, including martial arts and gymnastics.

Breaking, the official name for competitive breakdancing, will become an Olympic sport for the first time at the 2024 Paris Olympics. To help celebrate and spread recognition of the sport here in Australia, the inaugural Redline Games in 2022 will host a crew of competing B-Boys and B-Girls, all breaking it out to determine the best breakdancer.

Breaking at the Redline Games is an exhibition only event and is not suitable for novice athletes.

Comments



- This was the first Battle Series to be hosted as part of a Sydney Sports Festival. This platform lifts Breaking's recognition and legitimacy as an Olympic sport, and the dynamic and athleticism of Breaking will attract new viewership for the sports festival.
- 40 registered Breakers competed which included interstate participants from Queensland, Victoria, South Australia, and Western Australia.
- Minor challenges were presented due to floods and heavy rain that covered NSW. Despite this, the event was carried out successfully and plans are already set to include Breaking in the Redline Games 2023.
- DJ Naiki did a great job bringing the atmosphere to the battles. As always, he proves himself as one of Sydney's most reliable battle DJs.
- Ultimately, the deserved winners were Bgirl Raygun for the 1v1 Bgirl category, and Bboy Icey for the 1v1 Bboy category. It was a great result to see Breakers who use a more artistic and "original" approach place highly in this event.
